## What is Assisted Living?

Assisted Living is a viable housing option for many elders requiring varying kinds of service and/or care. In Indiana, Assisted Living must be a registered Housing with Services Establishment (HSE). Depending on the types and levels of services provided, they may be licensed by the Indiana State Department of Health. Assisted Living facilities may stand alone or be located contiguous to other kinds of elder living environments; including apartments or comprehensive care facilities.

IALFA is committed to enhancing resident choices and actively encourages a variety of creative solutions for all kinds of assistance models for a variety of income levels.

## How do we do it?

- ▲ Active participation on state committees and workgroups of the Indiana State Department of Health and the Family and Social Services Division of Aging.
- ▲ Proposing bills and lobbying for regulations and rules that are appropriate for effective operations of varied kinds of service levels for the health and safety of the assisted living resident.
- ▲ Collaborating and working with the other state based trade associations representing the continuum of housing, care and service for the elderly
- ▲ Staying informed on and communicating with national organizations devoted to the continuance of an appropriate regulatory environment that allows the assisted living resident a variety of living models from which to choose.
